RULES, ETC.

GENERAL RULES & TIE-BREAKERS

The tournament will be governed by Hockey Canada rules and 2024-25 Hockey Calgary Play Guidelines.

All games will be 90 minutes, including a three minute warm-up, followed by 75 minutes of stop time play, consisting of a 15 minute 1st period, a 15 minute 2nd period and a 20 minute 3rd period (with floods after the second period of each game).

When the game reaches five minutes before the end of the 75 minute allotted regulation time, the clock will be reset to 2:00 minutes at the first stoppage of play and the remainder of the game will be played stop time.

Each team will be allowed to call one 30-second timeout per game.

If the game is tied after regulation time, a 3 minute sudden death 3-on-3 overtime period will take place with 3 skaters and a goaltender without teams changing ends.

If the game remains tied after the 3-on-3 overtime period, an NHL style shoot-out will determine the winner, whereby each team will select 3 shooters, the Home team will have the option to shoot first or second and the teams will alternate shots.

If the game is still tied after the initial 3 players from each team have taken their shots, teams will select alternate players to take penalty shots on a "sudden death" basis until the tie has been broken.

All skaters are eligible to participate in the shoot-out unless serving a 10 minute misconduct and no player can be selected to be a second time shoot-out participant until all skaters have had an opportunity to shoot once.

Teams will provide two volunteers per game as scorekeeper/timekeeper and penalty box manager and all team rosters, including registered and approved affiliates, are required and must be on hand for each game.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Round Robin Play

The tournament format consists of a double-sided Round Robin (*Blue Round Robin* and *Green Round Robin*) whereby each team will play four games, including three Round Robin games, followed by a Medal Game (Gold, Silver, Bronze or Consolation).

Points will be awarded for each Round Robin games as follows:

- two points for a win,
- one point for an over-time loss, and
- zero points for a loss.

Ties in the standings after Round Robin play will be broken by applying the following criteria in the following order presented:

- the team with the most wins;
- the team with the best record in the games played between the tied teams if they played;
- the team with highest value of goals for divided by goals against;
- the team with fewest penalty minutes assessed overall; or
- by a coin toss.

Medal Round Play

All Medal Round participation for each team will be determined as follows:

The two teams with the most points at the end of each respective Round Robin will playoff in the Gold Medal Game (Blue First Place and Green First Place).

The two teams with the second most points at the end of each respective Round Robin will playoff in the Silver Medal Game (Blue Second Place and Green Second Place).

The two teams with the third most points at the end of each respective Round Robin will playoff in the Bronze Medal Game (Blue Third Place and Green Third Place).

The two teams with the least points at the end of each respective Round Robin will playoff in the Consolation Medal Game (Blue Fourth Place and Green Fourth Place).

CODE OF CONDUCT & BEHAVIOR

All players, coaches, parents/ guardians and spectators are expected to adhere to a code of conduct and maintain behaviour that ensures a safe and respectful environment for all players, coaches, officials and volunteers. All tournament participants share responsibility for upholding the integrity and spirit of the sport of hockey. Any contrary conduct or behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in expulsion from the tournament and the arena premises. Remember Hockey is a game that is meant to be fun for all participants.
